

1.0 Occupational health and safety statements of intent

The University of Guyana will: -

- (a) Remain committed to ensure full compliance with its legal and regulatory obligations in respect to all activities conducted on its campuses.
- (b) Ensure the necessary resources are available, as far as is reasonably practicable, to deliver successful health and safety risk management.
- (c) Provide training, instruction and information to all staff, students and any other party that may be affected, according to their roles and responsibilities.
- (d) Ensure the necessary systems and mechanisms secure effective dissemination and communication of, and consultation on, matters of safety, health and wellbeing.
- (e) Take all reasonable steps to prevent and minimize accidents or incidents to the University's staff, students and any other personnel that could be affected.
- (f) Encourage and actively promote health and safety best practices and initiatives through personnel and systems.
- (g) Communicate and consult with staff and students on health and safety issues and listen to feedback.
- (h) Constantly monitor and review occupational health and safety performance with the aim of continual improvement.



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
